Sunset Ridge Basketry

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Weaving Level - Beginner 6" Diameter x 3" H Circumference 21"



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Materials

<u>1</u> 4" Round Base - Circumference 12"

3/8 f Natural Spokes <u>10</u> @ 6" & Rims

3/8 f Dyed Spokes <u>10</u> @ 6"

#2 Round Twine the Base <u>2</u> @ 50"

#1 Seagrass Weaver <u>1</u> @ 260" & Rim Filler

#3 Dyed Weaver <u>1</u> @ 260"

1/4 f Rim Row

11/64 fo Natural Lasher 1 @ 50"

Please read all instructions before starting.

Trace the base on a piece of paper and cut it out. Fold the paper into quarters and pencil mark the quarter fold marks. Transfer the quarter marks, using a pencil, onto the bottom of the base. Evenly insert the spokes smooth side up alternating natural and dyed. Insert $\underline{1}$ at each quarter mark and $\underline{4}$ in between.

Twine 3 rows using #2 round, leaving the spokes flat.

Weave the sides. Push the spokes upward creating a gradual upset. Weave the sides allowing a slight flare.

#1 Seagrass & #3 dyed 13 rows of twining. Twine using 1 long piece of seagrass and a

long piece of #3 dyed. Start the 2 pieces behind 2 consecutive spokes with the #3 behind a natural spoke and the seagrass

behind a dyed spoke.

1/4 f <u>1</u> rim row. Start the rim row on a natural spoke.

Cut off all of the natural spokes even with the top edge of the rim row.

Tuck all of the dyed spokes into **6** rows of seagrass weaving.

Rim using 3/8 f inside and out, fill with seagrass and lash using 11/64 fo.
